Ship's Name "CYRENA"Official No. 181577

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in February, 1947.

- (1) One small access hatch (original construction) at the forward end of the forecabin deck fitted with hinged steel W.T. cover. Size of opening 18" x 15"; height of coaming 9".
- (2) Two (1P. 213) upper deck scuppers now fitted at after end of forward deck. Scuppers are 2 1/2" diameter and are led overboard through the ship's sides approximately 18" below the upper deck (in turn deck space).
- (3) Sections of the upper deck guardrails in way of the cargo hatches have now been made portable. Efficient means of securing the guardrails in their proper position have been fitted.
- (4) The wooden doors on the after bulkhead of the after bridge have now been replaced by steel doors, suitably stiffened, and capable of being operated from both sides.
