Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant enclosing one from the Chantiers de Normandie in further reference to the freeboard of their Tank Barge 26 "SERVICE SHELL VI"), and it is noted that the Builders state that the length of the barge has been altered and that the length reported by you is the length measured by the French Customs on the deck. AS you have not commented on this, I shall be glad if you will verify the length on the waterline and report to this Office.

If the length is 129 feet as given on the plans, the freeboard would be 514 mm. as stated by the Owners.

With regard to the other points raised in the Builders, I have to state that these will be dealt with on receipt of your report.
