

<p>With reference to your memorandum of the 24th November last, I shall be glad to learn how this case now stands.</p> <p>You will observe that the Boiler Survey will become due at the end of this month.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>San</i></p>	<p>Date:— 31st March 1931.</p> <p>Very little progress has been made on the repairs since the date of the memorandum referred to.</p> <p>The Owners state that owing to their financial position they are obliged to economise as much as possible and reduce expenses to a minimum, for this reason they may have to put the vessel into service again without completing all the repairs required.</p> <p>The repairs to the after deck plating, the boiler room and bunkers are almost completed, but these to the fore deck and shell plating have not been commenced.</p>
