The Special Survey was due in October 1961; in December 1961, a General Examination was carried out in Dry-dock, and upon the general satisfactory condition of the Ship the Committee agreed to the postponement of the Special Survey until October 1962.

We have now been informed by the Owners that they have been requested by the Indonesian Charterers to extend the present charter for a further three months, until the end of January 1963, as they are most anxious to comply with this request, they have enquired if the case could be placed before the Committee with a view to this postponement of the Special Survey being granted.

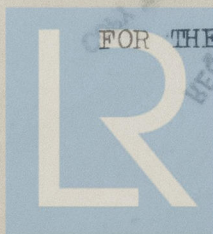
