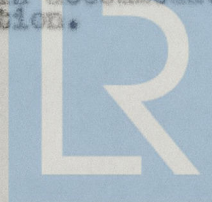
27982 "PENELOPE". As recommended. It is concluded that the pumping arrangements were also generally examined in accordance with Circular No.1959, but your confirmation is desired.

"ELETTA FASSIO". Having regard to the contents of your letter and enclosure of the 10th instant the notation ABS 3.63 has now been assigned.

28033 "ESPERIA". As recommended. To complete the Auxiliary Boiler Survey the port auxiliary boiler repairs require to be completed, the mountings to be examined, the safety valves to be adjusted and the oil burning system and remote controls to be examined. It is concluded that this survey is now being completed.

27812 "STELLA SOLARIS". The contents of this Report have been noted. This ship is eligible to be classed 100 A.1 "Mediterranean Service" when the Machinery Survey has been completed by the following electrical items:-

1. Fit earth leakage protection for main propulsion loops and earth leakage indication for propulsion excitation circuits.
2. Test all electrical power circuits for non-essential services on completion.
3. Test main and emergency lighting circuits in accommodation spaces on completion.
