We refer to your letter of the 9th January last and our subsequent telephone conversation with Mr. Cook and confirm that we did advise you, following the overhaul in July 1961, that we would not continue the classification of the above vessel.

Our usual procedure is for all vessels built on our behalf to be built to Lloyds standard and classification and after the initial running period we do not continue this classification as we build and repair our craft at our own works. In addition, we employ consultants for the m.v. "Charmo" and arrive at the view that it is not necessary for us to have any further safeguard factors.
