Doig (Grimsby) Ltd., Grimsby, attend their works on the 25th January, 1961, and subsequently, to examine during manufacture and subsequently to test hydraulically one cast iron stern tube intended for the M/V. "CHARMO", and made to the order of Messrs. Lister Blackstone Marine, Limited, Order No. 99280 dated 9th November, 1960.

This stern tube casting has been examined internally and externally, its dimensions verified, and found within close limits, subsequently tested hydraulically to 50 lbs.per. sq.inch and proved sound and tight.
