

(Main structure partly of P.5 & XNT Steel).


IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the Surveyors be advised that with future First Entry Reports the approved plans on which all Modifications and/or additions have been shown (refer Para.3 General Declaration) must be forwarded in accordance with Circular No.1962 etc.

They should also be advised that a statement should have been made in the appropriate space on Page 2 of their First Entry Report that satisfactory check tests were carried out on the steel not manufactured under the Society's supervision and letter references quoted in connection with its approval.

They should further be advised it is concluded the overall length and extreme breadth of ship are 463.16' and 61.21' respectively, and that the forgings and casting certificates listed on Page 4 of their report do not appear to have accompanied their report as stated.
