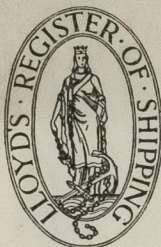

## Motorship "TELOK VI"

The case of the above-named ship has received the consideration of the Committee today in connection with the Special Survey which fell due last December.

When Owners desire to postpone a Special Survey, it is a requirement of the Rules that the ship be submitted to a General Examination by the Society's Surveyors at about the due date; but it is understood from the Djakarta Surveyor that he is unable to obtain any information from you on this point.

The Committee have therefore instructed me to say that if no satisfactory arrangement in regard to the Special Survey, or at least a General Examination as an interim measure, is received by the Committee by the 31st instant, they will not feel justified in further maintaining the ship in class. You must therefore appreciate that in the absence of any satisfactory information by that date, the class will in all probability then be suspended.

If you have any comments to make for the information of the Committee it will be appreciated if you will ensure that they are received here by the time stipulated.
