Dimensions 95.8' x 18.12' x 7.34'.

This ship was built in 1951 (launched 1950) at Djakarta and the Owners desire classification in this Society.

Plans have been approved see Secretary's letter to Djakarta Surveyor dated 9.4.53.

A report 8 has been received in which the Surveyor reports that a SPECIAL SURVEY (C) has been carried out.

The Surveyor reports (Rpt. 1) that the scantlings and arrangements as given in the report are as shown and amended on the approved plans.


The equipment has been examined and found good but although the Surveyor states that the certificates state it had been tested by Lloyd's, the marks were indecipherable.
