This ship was built in 1951 (launched 1950) at Djakarta, and Owners desire Classification with this Society.

Plans in connection with this have been approved, see Secretary's letter to Djakarta Surveyor dated 9.4.53.

The DKJAKARTA Surveyor now reports 3,53, ship examined in drydock, bottom coated and due to vessel discharging and loading while lying aground 2 channel bars have been fitted to 'B' strake (p & s).

A General Examination of the ship has also been carried out.

IT IS SUBMITTED no ACTION be taken in this case pending receipt of a First Entry Report and satisfactory Report 8 of Classification Survey.


