Consideration will be given to the case of the "WISNIAWSKI", on receipt of the First Entry and logs of the balance Test.

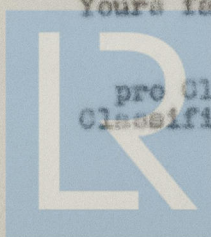
