When Mr. Chapman called here the other day to see Mr. McAfee he made reference to the case of the "LYRIA" now named "YEBALA". I understood from him that you were interested in the proposed conversion of this ship to a dry cargo vessel, but I now learn from our Antwerp Surveyors that, according to the local ship repairers, Messrs. Fulton Marine Engineering, this work is to be done under the supervision of the Bureau Veritas.

As the vessel holds a qualified class with Lloyd's Register perhaps you will be kind enough to let me know whether this transfer is contemplated as, if so, the Committee will doubtless be giving instructions for her class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book.
