Information has come to hand that the Anglo Saxon tanker "LYRIA" has been sold to Spanish Moroccan Owners and is to be converted to a dry cargo ship under the name of "YEBALA".

The ship, as a tanker, was overdue for Special Survey and had a notation of "Laid up - Surveys overdue" in the Register Book.

It is observed from the shipping papers that she arrived at Antwerp on the 17th instant from Falmouth and I shall be glad to learn as soon as possible whether you have yet been approached in regard to the proposed conversion.

A month or two back another prospective purchaser submitted plans for conversion to an ore carrier which was apparently dropped, but I shall be glad to have any information you may be able to glean as to the vessel's future.
