The castings have been tested as required by the Rules and found satisfactory.

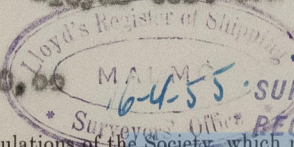
The pressure parts of the gear were in my presence subjected to a hydraulic pressure of 60 kg/cm² and found good.
