The class is subject to 15 fathoms of worn chain cable being replaced at the earliest opportunity, and to the rudder or rudder head (one piece) being renewed by 2,53.

In reply to a memorandum dated 11.2.53 the Split Surveyor states that the new rudder was not delivered at this time and it is proposed to deal with same by the end of April 1953.

The existing rudder head was now examined, found efficient and the Owners' proposal is submitted for favourable consideration.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the vessel be continued as classed, subject to 15 fathoms of worn chain cable being replaced at the earliest opportunity, and to the rudder or rudder head (one piece) being renewed by 4,53.
