
Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant respecting the visit which Mr. Caley has recently made to Vizagapatam, Coconada and Madras, in connexion with the survey of the small craft owned by the Government of Madras.

His reports on the Tug "GRAMPUS" and Breidger "GOUTHANI" have come to hand, but up to the time of writing no report has been received on the Breidger "MADRAS", although you state in your letter that this vessel was surveyed by him at the same time.

Your remarks as to the difficulty in obtaining a suitable person resident at Cochin to carry out minor surveys, and the difficulty of arranging to visit this district from your port has been duly noted, and in the circumstances your suggestion that a letter should be addressed to the Madras Government pointing out the position has been adopted, and I enclose for your information a copy of my letter on the subject.

On receipt of their reply I will not fail to communicate with you again, but should you receive any further information
