Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 2nd ultimo, with its enclosure, respecting the dredger "LORD WILLINGTON" and in reply I have to say that the Committee are agreeable to the Owners' proposal to postpone the survey of the screwshafts until the next drydocking of the vessel in six months' time. The Committee have also agreed to your suggestion that the Screwshaft and Boiler Surveys of this vessel should be carried out at Madras by a competent and independent Engineer, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

I have to add that the above arrangement also applies to the Screwshaft and Boiler Surveys of the tug "KERALA" and dredger "GOUTHAMI", belonging to the same Owners.

It will be observed that the Screwshaft Survey of the "KERALA" became due so long ago as November last and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements have been made for this inspection to be held.
