
Screw shaft Survey of the Dredger Lord Willingdon -
Your letter dated 28th May 1929.

I am directed to state that the port and starboard screwshafts of the dredger 'Lord Willingdon' have been withdrawn and new stern and A bracket bushes fitted within the last month.

2. It is presumed that you will wish to see the shaft withdrawn for examination and I am to enquire whether in view of the very recent overhaul it is possible to postpone the survey for a period of six months when the vessel will be dry docked again.

3. In this connection I am to point out that as the vessel is a suction dredger working with a pipeline her propelling engines are very seldom in use. The distance she will travel in the next six months will not in all probability exceed 10 miles.
