With reference to our telephone conversations today regarding this ship, I would confirm that she was built under survey and completed in June 1943 when a class of 100A1 "For Government Service" was assigned.

With regard to the present request, it will be in order for you to issue a provisional load line certificate for a voyage to Norway.

I would add, however, that as the vessel is now Norwegian owned, the present load line certificate and copy are invalid, but if you are able to state the limits of service desired by the new Owners, new Norwegian load line certificates could be issued from here.

It does not appear from the information available in this Office that any special preparations will be required for the voyage to Norway, but the Surveyors should of course satisfy themselves on this point by an examination of the ship.

If desired an interim certificate for the voyage in question can also be issued provided the vessel is found to be in a satisfactory condition.
