The case of the above named vessel recently received the consideration of the Committee, and in view of the fact that the vessel was laid up at your port with surveys overdue, the class was qualified by the assignment of a notation of "Laid up - Surveys overdue".

Messrs. Shell Tankers now state the vessel has been sold as she lies to the Kie Hock Shipping Co., Singapore, and I shall therefore be obliged if you will inform the new Owners of the fact that a Special Survey became due in April, 1955, and a Donkey Boiler Survey in September, 1955, also that these surveys will require to be held if the ship is to maintain her class.

Should she proceed into commission without these surveys being held, you should inform me immediately.
