proposal adopting the revised plans, assigned Feb/1943.
d to para 2 of the Secretary's letter 9/3/43 the only overboard
from spaces below C deck & between frames 48 + 100
a galley (1P+1S), which we propose fitting with an additional
valve, accessible for examination under service conditions.
I am glad to hear if this is approved.

As regards the sewage tank discharges within the
enclosed area, these are on an enclosed sewage system.

The rods to above C deck would involve an excessive
of work in accommodation spaces & as the vessel is
required, I shall be glad if you will let me know
it was intended that these valves be modified.
