It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to.

1. all side-scuttles the sill of which will be less than 6 inches above the new tropical loadline being permanently closed;
2. all ordered discharges, the scuppers and sanitary discharges, the inboard ends of which are situated in spaces below "C" Deck having screw-down automatic non-return valves controlled from "C" Deck.

The assignment, as amended has been made at the request (telephonic) of Capt. Blake, Owners' marine superintendent. A copy of the assignment letter should be sent to the Owners & to the Technical Officer, Sea Transport Dept. A copy of the computation should be sent to the Maritime & War Transport Dept. who should be requested to state what further amendments
