Referring to previous correspondence, I have to acquaint you that the vessel will leave Granton (Leith), on the 8th instant and proceed to Southampton, where it is intended to carry out a reclassification Survey and the necessary repairs.

It is presumed that the Southampton Surveyors will desire to have instructions in regard to the H.E.L. steel which has been subjected to heat and quenching and in this connection I enclose a report prepared by Mr. Lewis. The sample examined was taken from the stringer plate of B Deck, port side, at approximately Frame 153.

The Leith Surveyors will be forwarding a report and copy of Interim Certificate in due course.

The vessel has been taken over by Messrs. Shaw Savill from Messrs. Furness Withy.

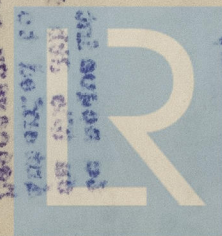
