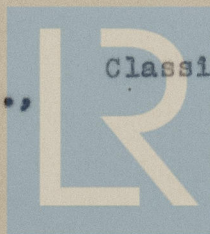
Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 10th instant and to previous correspondence respecting the steamer "MONARCH OF BERMUDA," I enclose, for your information, copies of letters which have now come to hand from Mr. Edgar and Mr. Ripley. Copies of these communications have also been sent to Dr. Webster of Glasgow, the Society's Principal Surveyor for Scotland, who has been advised that in the event of the vessel being prepared for the contemplated voyage, specimens of the H.B.L. steel from the topsides should be tested in order to ensure that the properties of the material have not been unduly affected by heat and water.
