I have to acknowledge receipt of your memorandum of the 23rd ultimo.

The circumstances in which the Owners are placed are noted, and while no action in regard to the vessel's class will be taken by the Committee at the moment, they consider that the matter should be placed on a more definite basis.

I shall therefore be glad if you will endeavour to obtain, as soon as possible, a definite proposal from the Owners in regard to their intentions, and in approaching them it is suggested that you might draw their attention to the provisions of Paragraph B.803 of the Rules, which provides that the Committee are prepared to consider postponement of a Special Survey, provided the ship is submitted to a satisfactory General Examination. The result of your discussion with the Owners on these lines is awaited.
