
Dear Sir,

We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, respecting the case of the steamer "MARQUES DE URQUIJO".

In accordance with your instructions I called upon the Owners to-day and discussed the question of retaining Lloyd's Class in the case of the above vessel, with the two Superintendents and the Manager. These gentlemen state that the Council of Administration decided that this vessel will only be employed in the coal trade between Asturias and Bilbao and also that, they did not desire to go to any expense for repairs and therefore they adhere to their previous decision to withdraw the vessel from our Class.

We understand the vessel is now being submitted to the inspection of the Comandante de Marina for entry in the Registro Español and will sail tomorrow without apperantly requiring any repairs.

This is just another instance of the difficulties to be faced in this Country with regard to Classification of Spanish vessels. When an Owner does not feel disposed to go



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to any expense in the up-keep of his vessel he has no difficulty in transferring her to either the Bureau Veritas or Registro Español Class, and appears to obtain practically the same conditions of insurance in which ever class he may choose.
