that the vessel sailed for Venice, on the 15<sup>th</sup> inst.

As regards the enclosed letter  
from Owners, our opinion is that it would  
be impracticable to discern whether the vessel  
had a list of one inch, either to port or starboard  
but at the same time, we would respect-  
fully submit, that the freeboards in this  
case, may be set off, from the part awning  
deck (statutory line), on each side; irrespective  
of the main deck.
