Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "MARUJA Y AURORA", I beg to inform you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyor at Barcelona intimating that he has received a letter from you to the effect that, as this vessel is only employed in the coasting trade, you no longer desire to continue her classification with this Society.

With regard thereto I have to remind you that the Third Special Survey No.1, which became due on the vessel so long ago as April, 1933, has not yet been completed, and the Committee, in May last year, only agreed to the postponement of this survey on the understanding that it was completed within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules, namely by the end of last month.

In view, however, of the fact that this period has now expired, and of your decision, as conveyed by the Society's Surveyor at Barcelona, I am directed to inform you that the Committee, who have had the case before them at their meeting today, regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with
