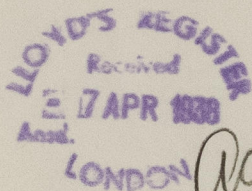

In reply to your letter of the 1st instant regarding the pumping arrangements in the M.V. "COXWOLD", Goole Shipbuilding & Repairing Company's Yard No.330, we have discussed the matter with the Builders, and it has been arranged to fit a non-return valve in pipe No.9 so as to prevent water drawing back into the hold from the engine room. A non-return valve is already fitted in the bilge box E. controlling the engine room suction No.6

This valve will be fitted in the near future next time the vessel is in Goole.

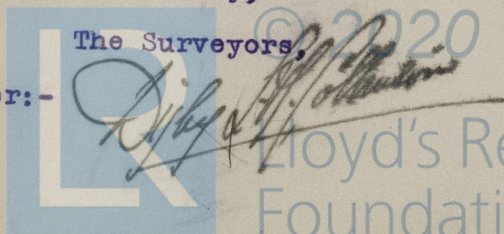

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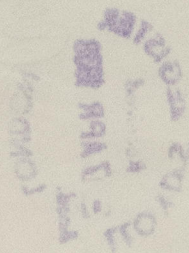
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
