A SPECIALS URVEY (B) became due 11.53.

The Notation "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue" was inserted in the Register Book 11.6.54.

The class is subject to bottom plating in way of fore peak dry space and fore deep tank and heavily corroded keel plating being renewed and indented shell plating (p & s) being dealt with as necessary by the next Special Survey, also to main engine sea inlet valve being removed and shell plating in way examined (leakage) at next drydocking.

The previous history of this case is fully stated on Endorsement dated 28.3.55.

In a letter dated 15.4.55 the TRIESTE Surveyors state that the Owners do not intend to continue the class of ship with Lloyd's Register.

In view of this IT IS SUBMITTED the ship's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
