in April 1952.

Ullage plug in bridge space to No.5 centre cargo tank now repositioned  
further aft, outside bridge space, original opening efficiently blanked.

Bridge space companionway, opening at bridge deck plated over inside  
bridge accommodation and new gastight access hatch fitted in way. Hatch  
opening 27" x 24" with 6" x  $\frac{3}{8}$ " coaming and  $\frac{3}{8}$ " gastight steel cover secured by  
four toggle bolts.
