As stated in our letter of the 29th of August 1962, the Ship was withdrawn from Service without being submitted for a General Examination for further postponement of the Special Survey.

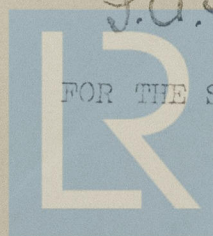
We have now received a letter from the Owners stating that they desire to relinquish the Class, and continue with the Freeboard only.
