2. Tonnage hatch steel cover removed and wooden covers secured from below with hemp lashings fitted. ✓
3. Tweendeck bulkhead tonnage opening portable steel plate rubber jointing removed. ✓
4. Hatches and closing appliances on freeboard deck examined and found satisfactory. ✓
5. Freeboard marks for O.S.D. condition painted and verified. C.S.D. condition marks obliterated. ✓
6. A short term L.L. Certificate valid until 22-nd May, 1963 has been handed to the Master. ✓
