Leith Surveyors rang Publications asking why the s.s. "NASPRITE" (936 tons gross) was omitted from 1955/6 R.B. and whether we could confirm that the Admiralty still owned the ship as someone was interested in chartering it.

Confirmation was obtained from the Admiralty that they still owned the ship and that it was in reserve in Devonport Dockyard.

Leith Office was notified of this and asked to keep us informed as to whether the chartering did actually take place as the question of re-entry into the R.B. as a disclassed ship would arise.
