Periodical Surveys, when held, must be reported in detail and in the terms of the Rules and Regulations to complete the Survey should be commenced. State clearly the nature of Repairs, if any, and in detail the nature and extent of the repairs and subsequent repairs. Repairs on account of damage to the hull or to the machinery must be stated separately from repairs due to other causes; and besides being detailed in the body of the report, should be summarised in the form of a table. When the replacement of anchors or chains is reported the particulars should be clearly stated in the space provided on the form. State also the date and initials of any surveyor inspecting this case.

In damage cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he offered his services for this purpose and to whom and why they were declined.
