
I have to acquaint you that the steamer "KAHANUI", Messrs. The Dublin Dockyard Co's No. 121, has proceeded to your port, ~~to have~~ the machinery installed, and in order to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done, viz:- Machinery casings to be riveted up, decks to be laid in way of same and tested, hand pumps and engine bilge and ballast pumps to be tested, windlass and steering gear to be tested under working conditions, and the whole of the outfit, stores, etc. to be checked and placed on board.

I shall therefore be glad if you will arrange for the case to have the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to the satisfaction of the Surveyors to forward a report on form 8, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
