Dear Mr. Warlow,


I am in receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant, regarding the fees for the survey of the electrical installation of the steamer "KAHANUI", and should at once make it clear that it was not intended by my letter of the 19th instant to interfere in any way with the general instructions on the subject referred to in the copy of correspondence which you enclose.

In the present instance it was understood here that the 15 kilowatt electric generator is employed in connexion with the salvage gear of the vessel. A special fee is being charged to the owners for seeing the specification carried out, which, of course, includes the inspection of this electric generator, but it was considered that it should not be dealt with in considering the special survey fees chargeable for the classification of the vessel.

If the 15 kilowatt electric generator is not to be solely used in connexion with the salvage gear, you might kindly let me know.
