


S.S. "KAHANUI".

IT IS SUBMITTED the Glasgow Office be informed that the case of the salvage tug "KAHANUI" was dealt with upon its own merits and therefore does not effect the instructions contained in the Secretary's letter of the 24th February 1921 respecting the fees for the inspection of the installation of electric fittings on board vessels.

It may be mentioned that in this instance it had been arranged that the Society's Surveyors should supervise the carrying out of the specification and that a special additional fee of £77.10.0 would be charged.

So far as is known at this Office the 15 horsepower electric generator in question is used in connexion with the salvage gear of the vessel and therefore should be specially considered as not being part of the usual equipment of the vessel and also in view of the special additional fee previously mentioned.
