"EBRO" of Monrovia, 7,120 tons gross, whilst she was lying afloat in Calais Docks, on the 12th of November, 1962, for the purpose to test under proof load the steel derricks (5 T. SWL) of No. 3 Hold after repairs now done at Calais by Messrs. Ateliers ROGLIANO.-

The statutory load of 6,250 Tons was applied on the Port & Starboard Steel derricks of No. 3 Hold, placed with an angle of 46° to the horizontal and a careful examination made during and after testings showed that the derricks remained in good condition without injury or permanent deformation.-
