M.S. "ARABIAN QUEEN".


We would refer to our memorandum dated 28th March concerning the Special Survey of the above named vessel, and have to state that we are now advised by the Owners that the charter will expire on the 15th July next. The ship is at present trading between Ratanura in the Persian Gulf and Aden and it is expected that she will remain in this trade until the close of the charter. In the circumstances the Owners submit that the class may remain undisturbed for the time being and that the validity of the Load Line Certificate may be extended until the end of July next.

It is understood that the ship will be offered for sale and is most likely to be broken up.

She is expected to call at Aden about the 28th instant, on which occasion a Renewal Load Line Survey could be arranged.

We should be glad to be informed of the reply to be given to the Owners.
