Referring to my memorandum about the tug "CASWELL" ex "ASSISTANT," I now learn from The Alexandra Towing Co., Ltd., that they do not desire to keep this tug in Classification.

They bought her from the Mersey Docks & Harbour Board with the Special Survey just due and with a passenger certificate still valid.

The Dock Board used the ship for taking some of their maintenance workers about Merseyside.

The Alexandra Towing Co., Ltd., however, propose using the vessel only on Dock Service at Swansea for a few months. They are therefore, not asking the Ministry of Transport for renewal of the passenger certificate and do not wish to keep the vessel in Lloyd's Register's class.

In any case she is likely to be scrapped next summer.
