With reference to your letter of the 11th and my reply of the 14th instant regarding the case of the converted L.C.T. No. 835, now named "ADULIS", I beg to acquaint you that the reports on the case (Glasgow 72214) were placed before the Sub-Committee of Classification at their meeting today, when it was decided to confirm the Surveyors' recommendation that classification be withheld pending the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyor at Port Said. In the circumstances, action as regards class has been deferred.

At the same time, I was directed to state that the committee will be very interested to hear, in due course, of the result of the Survey at Port Said, and consequent action taken by the Classing Committee in London.
