Dear Sirs,

M. With reference to your letter of the 17th instant, relative to the Furness Shipbuilding Co's No. 212 ship, I have to request that you will advise the Builders that the Summer freeboard under the Convention would be about  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inches less than under the present Board of Trade Regulations, viz. about 1'11" from a statutory deck line level with the top of the steel upper deck at side; subject to all the Convention requirements being complied with.
