It is submitted before this case receives consideration the Surveyors be requested to forward a copy of their letter dated 30th May 1919 regarding the change in the shape of the main frames, as the original, if received, appears to have been misunderstood. They should also be requested to state whether the thickness of A, B, & C Strakes of the shell plating is reduced .04" in way of the hull bottom attachments and the bridge deck plating increased in thickness in way of the openings as approved and whether an efficient hand steering gear is fitted or other secondary means of steering provided as required by the Rules.
