Dear Mr Watt,

I duly received your letter the 15th instant, with regard to long bridge to be fitted in The Caledon Co's No 254. I have seen the builders this afternoon, and find that the bridge is to be 149'-6" x 7'-9", extending full breadth of vessel and with no openings in the sides. The openings in bridge out, (in way of alleyways), are to be closed by hinged steel doors, fitted in two halves. After the bridge is to remain open.
