Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th instant relative to the fees to be charged in the case of the Steamer "OAKLEY", and it is noted it has been decided these are to be limited to £180. It is concluded this is an inclusive fee covering both hull and machinery and the account will be rendered in accordance with the instructions.
