

"O A K L E Y"

With reference to Messrs. Horace S. Cordrans' letter of the 16th instant, they have been informed by telephone that this ship was built to Germanischer Lloyd requirements and classed for K. type coasting, which permitted navigation between European ports and to Mediterranean and Black Sea ports, ports on the West Coast of Africa North of the 12° parallel and also to ports of the Cape Verde and Canary Islands.

So far as this Society is concerned the trading limits would require to be precisely defined by the Owners and if approved an appropriate qualification of class defining the limits would appear in the Register Book.

Messrs. Cordran stated that their Client had in view a coast-wise trade in the Mombasa area and promised to communicate with this Office if, and when, necessary.
