Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the Steamer "OAKLEY", the contents of which are noted.

In reply I have to say that on the occasion of the survey which terminated in March last at Newcastle-on-Tyne, a complete Special Survey of the hull was carried out and therefore it was possible to assign a record of Special Survey in this respect in association with the date of March 1950. In the case of the machinery survey however credit was given for the major portion of this inspection which was carried out by the British Corporation Surveyors from July 1948 to March 1949 and for this reason the date assigned was necessarily March 1949 as distinct from March 1950 when only the few outstanding items were dealt with.

I think it well to add that the next Special Survey of the hull and machinery will be regarded as becoming due in March 1954.

The remarks contained in your concluding paragraph are receiving attention and will form the subject of a further communication shortly in regard to the Load Line Certificate.
