The whole question has now been under re-consideration in this Office and, in view of all the circumstances, it has been decided to recommend to the Committee on completion of the survey for classification, the assignment of a class of BS (For Service between European and African ports North of 12°N: also between ports in East Africa North of 30°S, India, Malaya, China and Japan).
